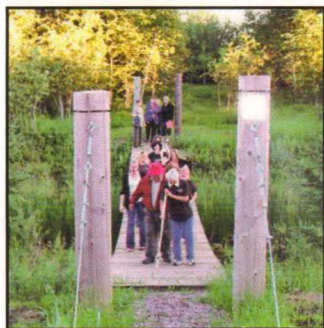

Walking Trail

The Town of Canora is very proud of its newly created 8.6 km walking trail. Saskatchewan wild flowers flourish along the edges of this beautiful trail as it winds through Canora's natural landscape. The Town has planted 1200 trees and shrubs comprising of 13 species over the last 3 years with future plans to continue planting. Walk, run, bike, or ski this great trail, that connects with the Trans Canada trail and the Urban Habitat trail.

Urban Habitat Trail

Connecting with the walking trail (see town map), the Urban Habitat Trail was created by the River Ridge Wildlife Club and formed in-cooperation with the town of Canora, Ducks Unlimited Canada and the PFRA. This trail is an educational and interpretive green space located on the northeast side of town along Whitesand Drive. The project consists of a walking path, foot bridge, several native tree species as well as twelve interpretive stops along the trail each highlighting a different aspect of habitat, wildlife & plant species and their importance to us and our environment.

Civic Centre

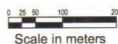
