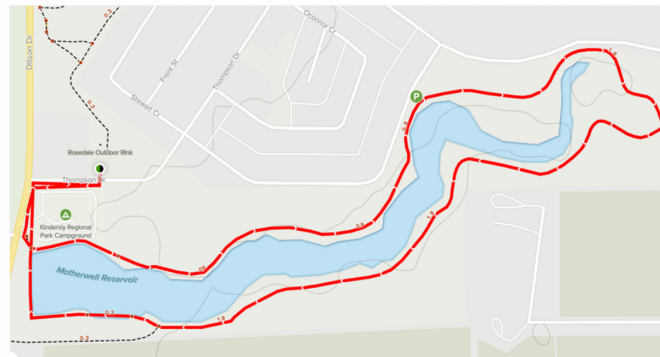
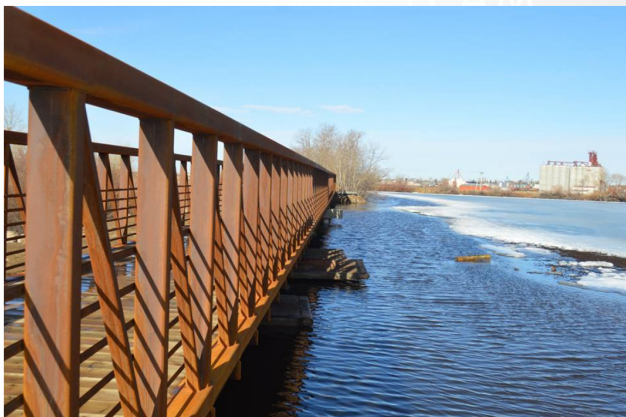


Kindersley Walking Trail Open Year Round

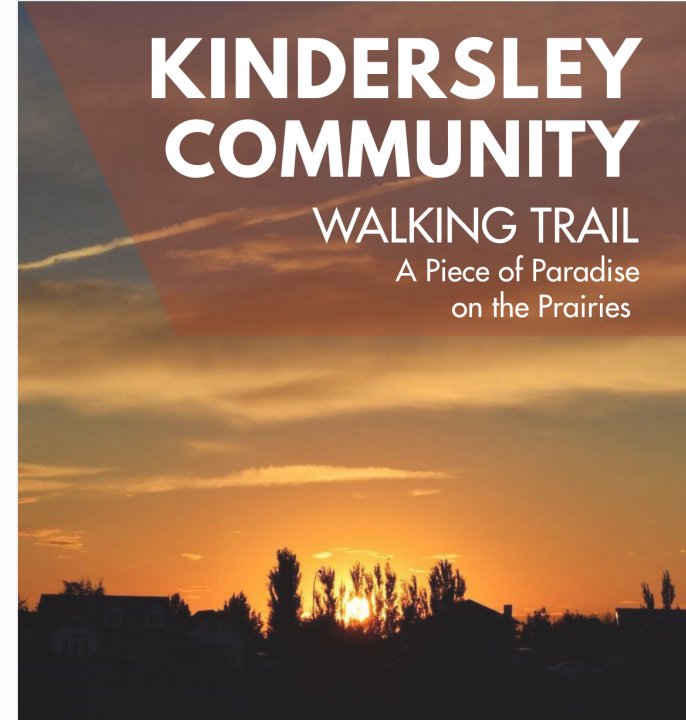

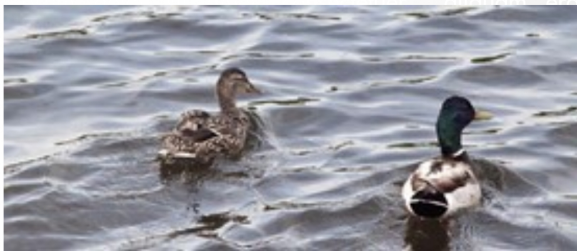

The Kindersley Community Walking Trail offers benches, picnic areas, waste receptacles, and a beautiful pedestrian bridge. The trail is paved most of the way, making it an accessible experience for strollers and wheelchairs depending on weather conditions. Parking is available nearby. Leashed dogs are allowed.
